DELIVERY

The Phase 1B infrastructure work to complete access to the primary school and community hub as well as a parcel to be delivered by Keepmoat Homes, is anticipated to be completed by the end of January. On completion, Keepmoat Homes will be starting work on their parcel and we are intending to commence the Phase 1C infrastructure work. The Phase 1C works are programmed to be completed by summer 2021; this section of infrastructure is the final section of primary infrastructure in Phase 1 and marks an exciting milestone for the development.


It was a good opportunity to set out the progress of the development to date as well as set out the key upcoming milestones in the future. We will look to facilitate another information event later in 2021.

PARK NEWS

A reserved matters planning application (WP/20/00793/REM) was submitted to Wellingborough Borough Council in November 2020 for 148 dwellings (45% affordable) on parcel R10a, Niort Way, Glenvale Park. It seeks the approval of conditions regarding access, appearance, landscaping, layout, and scale including discharge of conditions and is currently scheduled for the February planning committee.

A second reserved matters planning application (WP/20/00811/REM) has also been submitted to Wellingborough Borough Council by Persimmon Homes for the discharge of conditions relating to the outline planning application (WP/16/00271/VAR) for 210 units on Parcel R7 of the Glenvale Park. This includes the layout, scale and appearance, vehicle, cycle and foot access routes, and hard and soft landscaping.


