DELIVERY NEWS

As reported in our January newsletter the Phase 1B infrastructure work to complete access to the primary school and community hub as well as a parcel of land to be delivered by Keepmoat Homes, is now complete.

Phase 1C infrastructure work has now commenced and is due to be completed by summer 2021. This work is the final main section of infrastructure for Phase 1 and marks an exciting milestone for the development.

SOCIAL VALUE

Through our research it has been revealed that Glenvale Park is forecasted to generate £1.62bn of social value for the local community. With the construction process expecting to cost in the region of £800m, that means the development would deliver £2.03 of social value for every £1 spent on construction.



Our development will create nearly 900 jobs and apprenticeships during the construction process. These jobs will be in addition to those generated from the commercial elements of the masterplan which include a new business park and a new local centre.

Glenvale Park will also deliver a community hub, two primary schools, a care home, retail space and a 25,000m² business park, which will house up to 3,000 additional jobs once constructed.

The development will create over 200 acres of parkland, the same area as 3,200 tennis courts. There will also be over 10,000 trees planted and retained across the development.

The findings will be continually monitored and updated to reflect our long-standing commitment to the local community and ensure the benefits from the development can be maximised for all.

- Reserved matters consent reference WP/20/00793/REM was granted on 4 February 2021 for 148 dwellings (47.3% affordable) on parcel R10a, Niort Way, Glenvale Park, Wellingborough. (Developer Northants LLP).
- Reserved matters consent reference WP/20/00811/REM was granted on 17 March 2021 for 210 units on Parcel R7 of the Glenvale Park. (Developer Persimmon Homes).
